ORDINANCE No. 10 of 1950.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Animals Diseases Ordinance, 1936, A.D. 1950. with respect to the importation of animals into the Colony by aircraft, and for purposes connected therewith.

[8th April, 1950.]

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Animals Diseases (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be construed and read as one with the Animals Diseases Ordinance, 1936, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Short title.

2. Subsections (3) and (5) of section thirteen of the Principal Ordinance are hereby amended by the substitution for the words "or at a port of entry" of the words "or on board any vessel or aircraft at a port of entry".

Animals suffering from or suspected of disease.

3. Section fourteen of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion therein after the words "any vessel" and "master of the vessel" of the words "or aircraft" and "or commander of the aircraft" respectively.
