ORDINANCE No. 17 of 1950.

An Ordinance to provide for the collection of taxes by the Mayor and Town Council of New Amsterdam during the year nineteen hundred and fifty.

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title. No. 25 of

1949.

This Ordinance may be cited as the New Amsterdam Town Council (Validation of Tax) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be construed with the New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance, 1949, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Validation of levy of taxes in respect of 1950.

2. The municipal taxes levied by the Council during the month of December, nineteen hundred and forty-nine, in respect of the year nineteen hundred and fifty, shall be deemed to have been levied in accordance with the provisions of subsection (1) of section one hundred and twenty-four of the Principal Ordinance, and shall be valid for all the purposes of the Principal Odinance.
