ORDINANCE No. 27 OF 1953.

An Ordinance to amend the law relating to certain Statutory Authorities.

[31st December, 1953]

Enacted by the Governor of British Guiana in accordance A.D. 1953 with the provisions of Part III of the British Guiana (Constitution) (Temporary Provisions) Order in Council, 1953.

This Ordinance may be cited as the Statutory Authorities Short title. Ordinance, 1953.

2. (1) As from the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance the Order made by the Governor on the 2nd of July, 1953, under section four of the British Guiana (Constitution)

Order in Council, 1953, shall cease to have effect.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in subsection (1) of this section the amendments contained in the Order referred to in certain the said subsection and specified by reference to the said Order in the First Schedule to this Ordinance shall continue to have effect as if they formed part of this Ordinance.

3. (1) As from the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance the Order made by the Governor on the 6th of November, 1953, under section four of the British Guiana (Constitution) Orders in Council, 1953, shall cease to have effect.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in subsection (1) of this section the amendments set out in the First Schedule to the Order referred to in the said subsection shall continue to have effect as amend-

if they formed part of this Ordinance.

4. (1) It is hereby specifically declared that save as is otherwise provided in this section wherever any amendment contained in the Orders referred to in subsection (1) of section two and subsection (1) of section three respectively of this Ordinance provisions ceases to have effect by virtue of the provisions of this Ordinance when the provisions which the said amendments replaced shall, on the amendsaid amendments ceasing to have effect as aforesaid, be revived; cease to and, in respect to all matters done after the coming into force have of this Ordinance, the Ordinances to which the said amendments effect. related shall be construed as if the said amendments had never been made.

For the avoidance of doubts it is hereby declared that all acts done between the second of July nineteen hundred and fifty-three, and the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance, by or in the name of all or any of the authorities Statutory authorities mentioned in the Fourth Schedule to this Ordinance and all acts done between the said dates by sons acting any person acting or purporting to act under the direction of any of the said authorities shall be deemed to be and to have been always validly and properly done; and, any such person as aforcsaid is hereby freed, discharged and indemnified from all legal proceedings whatever, whether civil or criminal, in respect of any such act as aforesaid.
