An Ordinance further to amend the Intoxicating Liquor Licensing Ordinance.

[19th June, 1954.] Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Intoxicating Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be construed and read as one with the Intoxicating Liquor Licensing Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Section eleven of the Principal Ordinance as amended by section thirty of the Intoxicating Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952, is hereby further amended—

Amendment of section 11 of the Principal Ordinance. No. 30 of 1952.

(a) by the substitution for the words "The board" in subsection (2) of the words "Any member of the board on the direction of the chairman";

(b) by the insertion of a full stop after the words "licensing meeting" in subsection (3) and the deletion of all the words thereafter to the end of the subsection.
