ORDINANCE NO. 57 OF 1955.

An Ordinance to amend the Registration of Births and Deaths Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1955.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Registration of Births Short title. and Deaths (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the Registration of Births and Cap. 139. Deaths Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.
