An Ordinance to amend the Georgetown Cultural Centre Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:-A.D. 1964.

Short Title.

Cap. 204

This Ordinance may be cited as the Georgetown Cultural Centre (Amendment) Ordinance, 1964, and shall be construed and read as one with the Georgetown Cultural Centre Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Amendment of section 5 of Chapter 204.

- Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended:
 - by the repeal of subsection (2) thereof;
 - (b) by the renumbering of subsections (3) and (4) as subsections (2) and (3) respectively; and
 - by the substitution for the renumbered subsection (3) (c) of the following subsection —
 - "(3) The Board may for such purposes as it may deem fit dispose of the eastern portion of the parcel of land on the plan specified in the description of the area aforesaid."

Insertion of section 5A of Chapter

- The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after section 5 of the following section —
- "Erection of 5A. Where it is necessary so to do for the purposes for buildings on which the Board may dispose of the parcel of land in eastern portion. pursuance of subsection (3) of section 5 of this Ordi-

nance, buildings may be erected thereon to give effect to such purposes, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any other Ordinance."
