Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title.

Cap. 112.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Accidental Deaths and Workmen's Injuries (Compensation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963, and shall be construed and read with the Accidental Deaths and Workmen's Injuries (Compensation) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

Amendment of section 4 of Chapter 112. 2. Paragraph (b) of the proviso to section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "twelve calendar months" appearing therein and the substitution therefor of the words "three years".

Application of Ordinance.

3. The provisions of this Ordinance shall extend to the case of any person whose death has been caused in the circumstances specified in subsection (1) of section 3 of the Principal Ordinance within three years prior to the commencement of this Ordinance:

Provided that the provisions of this Ordinance shall not extend to actions determined prior to the commencement of this Ordinance.
