BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE NO. 17. OF 1934.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Customs Duties Ordinance, Chapter 34, with respect to the duties on certain articles.

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Duties Ordinance, Short Title. 1934, and shall be construed with the Customs Duties Ordinance, Chapter 34. hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any amending Ordinance.
