ORDINANCE NO. 19 OF 1934.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Customs Duties Ordinance, Chapter 34, with respect to the rates of duty on certain articles.

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Duties Ordinance Short Title. (No. 2), 1934, and shall be construed with the Customs Duties Cap. 34. Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Amendment to First Schedule to Cap. 34. No. 44 of 1932. 2. The first Schedule to the Principal Ordinance, as amended by section two of the Customs Duties Ordinance, (No. 2), 1932, is hereby further amended by deleting item 5a.

Amendment to Second Schedule to Cap. 34. No. 44 of 1932. 3. The following are hereby substituted for the corresponding items in the Second Schedule to the Principal Ordinance, as amended by section three of the Customs Duties Ordinance (No. 2), 1932:—

The duties leviable under the provisions of this Ordinance shall Exclusion of not apply to any articles which are proved to the satisfaction of certain the Comptroller of Customs to have been ordered on or before the 28th day of June, nineteen hundred and thirty-four, provided that Ordinance. such articles are imported before the 1st day of October, nineteen hundred and thirty-four.
