## BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE NO. 20 OF 1934.

An Ordinance to amend the Income Tax Ordinance, Chapter 38, by exempting from tax the official emoluments of the Officer Administering the Government.

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Income Tax Ordinance, Short Title 1934, and shall be construed with the Income Tax Ordinance, here-Cap. 38 inafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Amendment to sec. 8 of Cap. 38 and repeal of sec. 2 of Ord. 4 of 1932.

- 2.—(1) Section eight of the Prinicipal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting the following as paragraph (a) thereof:—
  - "(a) the official emoluments received by the Officer Administering the Government."
- (2) Section two of the Income Tax Ordinance, 1932, is hereby repealed.

Commencement 3. This Ordinance shall come into operation with the year of assessment nineteen hundred and thirty-five.
