. ORDINANCE NO. 29 OF 1933.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Customs Duties Ordinance, Chapter 34, with respect to the duty on Edible Oil.

A.D. 1933.

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Logislatine Grand British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :-
