A BILL

Intituled

AN ACT to amend the Factories Act.

A.D. 1974 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Factories (Amendment) Short litle Act 1974.

Amendment 2 Subsection (1) of section 2 of the Principal Act is here-of section 2 by amended by the deletion of paragraph (b) of the definition of the word "factory" and the substitution therefor of the following paragraph -

> "(b) any premises or undertaking specified in the Sche-dule where persons are employed in manual la-bour and the Schedule may be amended by order made by the Minister." Schedule.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Factories Act applies to premises specified in the Schedule thereto where persons engaged in manual labour are em-ployed. It is considered desirable that the Act should apply to other places which may not be regarded in law as being premises, for example, installations used in the exploration of oil. This Bill accordingly seeks to enable this to be done.
