1. This Act, which amends the Public Officers Widows Act, may be cited as the Public Officers Widows (Amendment) Act 1974 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1973.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Section 4 of the Public Officers Widows Act (Chapter 27:07) empowers the payment of any sum of money not exceeding one hundred dollars which is due as salary from the Government to a public officer who dies, without the need for probate or other proof of title of the personal representative of the deceased.

The amount of one hundred dollars was fixed in 1920 when the Act was enacted. It is considered desirable that with the lapse of time the amount should be increased and this Bill seeks to increase the amount to a maximum of one thousand dollars.
