AN ACT to amend the Local $\,$ Authorities (Postponement of Elections) Act 1972.

A.D. 1974 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title No. 13 of 1972. 1. This Act, which amends the Local Authoritic. (Postponement of Elections) Act 1972, may be cited as the Local Authorities (Postponement of Elections) (Amendment) Act 1974.

Amendment of section 6 of the Principal Act.

2. Subsection (1) of section 6 of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "1976, or on such other date" for the words "1974, or on such earlier date".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to provide for the further postponement of elections of councillors of local authorities until 1976 or such other date as may be determined by the Minister. Under the existing legislation elections of councillors of local authorities are due to be held during the latter part of 1974.

The annual election of Mayors, Deputy Mayors, Chairmen, Vice-Chairmen and Deputy Chairmen of Local authorities will, however, continue to be held.
