SALE OF TRAVEL TICKETS BILL, 1978

ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

Section

1. Short title and commencement.
2. Interpretation.
3. Restriction on the sale of travel tickets.

A BILL

Intituled

AN ACT to impose restrictions on the sale of travel tickets in respect of journeys between Guyana and any other country.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title and commencement. 1. This Act may be cited as the Sale of Travel Tickets Act, 1978, and shall come into operation on 1st July, 1978.

Interpretation. 2. In this Act —
“scheduled journey” means one of a series of journeys which are undertaken between two or more countries of which Guyana is one and which together amount to a systematic service operated in such manner that the benefits thereof are available to members of the public from time to time seeking to take advantage of it;

“travel ticket” means any written instrument issued in Guyana whereby a person on a journey from Guyana is entitled for that purpose to be provided with transportation by aircraft on a scheduled journey.

Restriction on the sale of travel tickets. Schedule 3. (1) Subject to subsection (2), no person, other than a person mentioned in the Schedule, shall sell travel tickets to the public.

(2) The Minister may amend the Schedule by order which shall be subject to negative resolution of the National Assembly.

Offences. 4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of section 3(1) shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of five thousand dollars and to imprisonment for one year.
