## Intituled

An Ordinance to amend the Ministers, Members of the House of Assembly and Special Offices (Emoluments) Ordinance, 1965.

Enacted by the Lesislature of British Guiana:-

A.D. 1966.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Ministers, Members Short title of the House of Assembly and Special Offices (Emoluments) (Amend- and comment) Ordinance, 1966, and shall be construed and read as one with the Ministers, Members of the House of Assembly and Special Offices No. 7 of (Emoluments) Ordinance, 1965, hereinafter referred to as the Principal 1965. Ordinance.

- (2) This Ordinance shall be ideemed to have come into operation on the 1st January, 1965.
- 2. Subsection (2) of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is nereby amended by the insertion of the words "or Deputy Speaker" between the words "Speaker" and "•f".

The schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby further amended by the addition thereto of the following:-

Aroundment of schedule.

"10. The Deputy Speaker shall be paid a salary at the rate of \$4,200 per annum."

This Bill seeks to provide a salary of \$4,200 per annum for the person holding the office of Deputy Speaker of the House of Assembly.
