- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Medical Practitioners short title. (Registration) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1966, and shall be construed and read as one with the Medical Practitioners (Registration) Ordin-No. 29 of ance, 1959, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.
- 2. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby Amendment of Section 5 amended by the substitution of the words "eighteen months" for the of the Principal Ordinance.

OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to amend section 5 of the Medical Practitioners (Registration) Ordinance, 1959 to reduce to eighteen months the period of three years during which a person is now required to practise as a medical practitioner in any approved institution as a pre-requisite for registration as a medical practitioner in British Guiana under the provisions of Part III of the Colonial Medical Service Ordinance, Chapter 134.
