AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Short title-Ordinance, 1959, and shall be construed and read with the Customs Ordinance, and any Ordinance, are like the customs of the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Part 1 of the First Schedule to the Customs Ordinance (which as amended from time to time specifies the rates of import duties on certain articles) is hereby further amended by the insertion of the new items, classifications, and rates of import duty in the schedule hereto and by the substitution of the remaining items therein for the corresponding items, classifications and rates of import duty in Part 1 of the First Schedule aforesaid.

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 8th January, 1959.
