AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MISCELLANEOUS LICENCES ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Miscellaneous Short tile. Licences (Amendment) Ordinance, 1958, and shall be construed and read with the Miscellaneous Licences Ordinance, herein- Cap. 306. after referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "forty-eight dollars" in subsection (1) of the words "one hundred dollars".

3. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "ten dollars" in section 11 of the words "fifty dollars" and by the substitution for the reference to "\$10" in the marginal note to the said section of a reference to "\$50".
