other purposes, for the year commencing the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, the sum of four million, nine hundred and one thousand two hundred and ninety-four dollars has been provided for by law, and it is now requisite to make provision for the appropriation from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of British Guiana of torty-two million, one hundred and ninety-nine thousand, six hundred and

sixty-three dollars:

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:

This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordin- Short title. ance. 1959.

2. The Accountant General shall, on the warrant of the Governor, pay from the annual revenue of the year, commencing on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, and other resources of British Guiana a sum not exceeding in the aggregate forty-two million, one hundred and ninety-nine thousand, six hundred and sixty-three dollars as set forth in the schedule hereto for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of British Guiana, and for other purposes during the said year.
