The proviso to subsection (1) of section 2 of the Princi-2. pal Ordinance is hereby amended by the deletion of paragraph of section paragraph (r) and (h) ² of Chap (f) thereof, and by the renumbering of paragraphs (g) and (h) $\frac{2}{ter}$ of C. as paragraphs (f) and (g) respectively.

This Ordinance shall come into operation on such day Commence-3. as the Governor may by Proclamation appoint.

OBJECTIONS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to remove the exemption of domestic servants from the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Ordinance.
