### Intituled

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDIN-ANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Health short title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be construed and read with the Public Health Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Cap. 145. Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

This Bill seeks to replace the Deputy Director of Medical Services by the Assistant Director of Medical Services as Chief Executive Officer of the Central Board of Health and to delete certain references in the Public Health Ordinance to "Health Officers" whose designation is to be changed to "Medical Officers of Health."
