A BILL INTITULED

AN ORDINANCE FURTHER TO AMEND THE CIVIL LIST ORDINANCE BY INCREASING THE AMOUNT WHICH SHALL BE PAYABLE TO HER MAJESTY FOR DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF CERTAIN SERVICES.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana: —

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Civil List (Amend- short title. ment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Civil List Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Prin- cap. 68. cipal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.
