WHEREAS it is provided by paragraph (1) of article 97 of the Constitution of Guyana that the Director of Public Prosecutions shall be appointed by the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Public Service Commission tendered after the Commission has consulted the Prime Minister:

NOW THEREFORE acting under the aforementioned provision and by virtue and in exercise of all powers enabling me in that behalf I do hereby appoint EMANUEL ALEXIS ROMAO, Esquire, to be the Director of Public Prosecutions with effect from the 15th August, 1966.
