AN ACT to amend the Summary Jurisdiction (Petty Debt) Act to extend the civil jurisdiction of Magistrates' Courts.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Administration of Justice Act 2009.

Amendment of the Summary Jurisdiction (Petty Debt) Act. Cap. 7:01 2. Sections 3 and 4 of the Summary Jurisdiction (Petty Debt) Act are amended by the substitution for the words "fifty thousand" wherever those words appear, of the words "one hundred thousand".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to increase the limitation of the jurisdiction of a Magistrate's Court. At present a Magistrate may hear a civil matter involving a sum of fifty thousand dollars. This sum is now increased to one hundred thousand dollars.
