Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title.

1. This Act, which amends the Evidence (Proceedings in Foreign Tribunals) Act 1991 may be cited as the Evidence (Proceedings in Foreign Tribunals) (Amendment) Act 1992.

Amendment of section 2 of the Principal Act. 2. Section 2(f) of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the insertion after the words "section 3" of the words "and includes the competent authority named in an agreement".

Amendment of the Principal Act.

3. The Principal Act is hereby amended by the insertion after section 6 of the following section as section 6A —

"Power of the Court to assist in obtaining evidence for criminal proceedings. 6A. The provisions of sections 3 to 6 shall have effect in relation to the obtaining of evidence for the purposes of criminal proceedings as they have effect in relation to the obtaining of evidence for the purposes of civil proceedings.".
