EMPLOYMENT OF SHOP ASSISTANTS BEYOND THE TIME

The purposes for which and the periods of time during which shop essistants may be employed beyond the time specified in the First Schedule are as follows -

- 2. Where despatching or delivering orders received before the closing hour Not exceeding half an hour.

3. Checking and balancing cash Not exceeding half an hour."

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seaks to repeal the provisions of the Summary Jurisdiction (Offences) Act, Cep. 8:02, dealing with the prohibition of trading on Sunday.

This emendment has become necessary in view of the increase in economic activities and promotion of tourism, and the request of many proprietors of trading establishments for permission to vary the opening and closing hours of their establishments and to remove the prohibition on Sunday trading.

The Bill also seeks to amend the Shops (Consolidation) Act, Cap. 91:04, to allow for longer shopping hours and shopping on Sundays, and to regulate trading during the extended hours so as not to derogate from the existing benefits, including normal hours of work, overtime and holidays, enjoyed by shop assistants. The Bill also increases to reslistic levels, the existing momentary fines prescribed for offences under the Act.
