## A BILL

## Intituled

AN ACT to amend the Export and Import (Special Provisions) Act 1986.

A.D. 1986 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana :—

**Short title.** 1. This Act, which amends the Export and Import (Special Provisions) Act 1986, may be cited as the Export and Import (Special Provisions) (Amendment) Act 1986.

**Amendment of section 9 of the Principal Act.** 2. Section 9 of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the insertion, after subsection (4), of the following subsection (5) —

“(5) Without prejudice to the provisions of subsection (4), the Minister may by notification in the *Gazette* exempt, subject to such conditions as he may specify consignments of any class of goods, or consignments to any class of persons, from the provisions of subsections (1), (2) and (3).”

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend section 9 of the Export and Import (Special Provisions) Act 1986 (Act No. 8 of 1986) so as to empower the Minister to exempt consignments of any class of goods or consignments to any class of persons from the provisions of that section dealing with legalisation of shipping documents.
