AN ACT to amend the Prison Act.

A D. :1983 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

This Act, which amends the Prison Act, may be cited as the Short title., Cap. 11:01 Prison (Amendment) Act 1983.

Section 33 of the Principal Act is hereby amended in the mendment of section 33 of the following respects -Principal

- (a) by the substitution in subsection (3) for the words "or revoked" of the words "or the revocation thereof"; and
- (b) by the insertion immediately after subsection (3) of the following subsection as subsection (4) —

"(4) Where a person is sentenced to undergo a term of imprisonment for an offence committed within twelve months of his release on licence under subsection (1) that sentence shall commence at the expiration of the unexpired period of the sentence of imprisonment he is liable to serve under subsection (3).".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to insert a new subsection in section 33 of the Prison Act to provide that a sentence of imprisonment imposed on a person during the period of twelve months immediately following the date of his release on licence shall run consecutively with the unexpired portion of the sentence he is liable to serve calculated as at the date of his release under licence.
