PUBLIC CORPORATIONS (AMENDMENT) BILL 1983
ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

#### SECTION

1. Short Title
Amendment of section 54 of the Principal Act.

## A BILL

### Intituled

AN ACT to amend the Public Corporations Act.

A.D. 1983 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title. 1. This Act, which amends the Public Corporations Act, eap. 19:05 may be cited as t e Public Corporations (Amendment) Act 1983.

Amendment of section 54 of the Principal Act.

- 2. Section 54 of the Principal Act is hereby amended
  - (1) by the insertion immediately after subsection (1) of the following subsection as subsection (1A) -

"(1A) Where, with the approval of the appropriate authority, a person holding an appointment in the public service, other than a pensionable office within the meaning of the Pensions Act, or holding an appointment in the public service paid for out of an open vote —

- (a) is seconded or temporarily transferred from such appointment to an office with a corporation, the period during which he shall serve in that office shall count for superannuation rights or benefits on his retirement from the appointment from which he is seconded or temporarily transferred as if he had not been seconded or temporarily transferred;
- (b) is transferred from such appointment to a substantive appointment in an office with a corporation, sums by way of superannuation rights or benefits payable to him in respect of his service in the appointment from which he is transferred, if he had retired from such appointment on the date of his transfer shall be paid to him on his retirement from the office to which he is transferred or on his attaining the age of sixty years whichever is earlier, or to the legal personal representative on the death of such person, if he dies before the date of retirement or the attainment of sixty years";
- (2) by the insertion in subsection (3) after the words "(and to which the Pensions Act applies)" of the words "or to appoint the person holding an ap-

pointment in the public service to the appointment held by him", and

(3) by the insertion immediately after subsection (3) of the following subsection as subsection (4) —

"(4) The Minister may by order direct that all or any of the preceding provisions of this section shall apply to any body corporate established by or under any Act and specified in the order and thereupon those provisions shall apply to any officer, person or teacher mentioned in those provisions who is employed with that body corporate as they apply to any such officer, person or teacher who is employed with a corporation and for that purpose every reference in this section to a corporation shall be construed and have effect as a reference to that body corporate."

### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Public Corporations Act to provide for the superannuation rights or benefits of non-pensionable or open vote employees who are seconded or temporarily transferred or transferred to public corporations or other bodies corporate.
