THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE

(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) (No. 7) Order, 1967.
 - 2. Part I of the First Schedule to the Customs Ordinance is hereby amended—
 - (a) by the substitution, for the rates of import duty set out therein against the item numbers and classifications mentioned in the first and second columns of the schedule to this Order, of the rates of import duty set out in the third column of the said schedule against the same, respectively, there being chargeable accordingly additional duty calculated in the manner prescribed by paragraph 3 of the Customs Duties (Amendment and Imposition) Order, 1967, on imported goods classified under any such item number and referred to in that paragraph;
 - (b) by the deletion of the words "other than knitted or made of knitted fabrics" in the proviso added after Division 99 by virtue of an Order* made by the Governor-in-Council on the 1st June, 1955;
 - (c) by the substitution for the symbol and figures "\$1.00" in item 1 of the table of Export Duties of the symbol and figures "\$3.00":
 - (d) by the deletion of item 8 of the table of Export Duties, the renumbering of items 9 and 10 thereof as items 10 and 11, respectively, and the insertion therein of the following as items 8 and 9—

"8. Shrimp per lb. .07
9. Molasses per 100 L. Gal.45"
