## THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE (Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) Order, 1968.
- 2. Part III of the first Schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended
  - (a) by the renumbering of item 42 as item 42(1); and
  - (b) by the addition thereto of the following paragraph as paragraph (2) of item 42—
    - "(2) Films, chemicals, ink, silk fabric, nylon fabric, polyvinyl chloride in sheets, paper and paper board, for silk screen process printing, admitted as such by the Comptroller when imported by or on behalf of a silk screen process printing establishment."
