ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Made Under
THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE IT IS HEREBY
ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

The second proviso to the Trade Classification List and Tariff of Part I of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended —

- (a) by the insertion after the words “metal containers,” appearing in item (1) thereof of the words “plastic containers,”; and
- (b) by the addition of the following new item —

	Rate of import duty	
	Preferential tariff	General tariff
“(9) Ingredients admitted by the Comptroller for use in the manufacture of disinfectants for sale to the public.	2%	5%”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order reduces the rates of import duty on plastic containers for the packaging of goods manufactured or produced in the Colony. It also reduces the rates of import duty on ingredients for use in the manufacture of disinfectants for sale to the public.
