There shall be allocated to each candidate by the returning officer such symbol shown in the appendix to these Regulations as the returning officer shall, subject to any general or special directions given to him in that behalf by the Commissioner of Elections, determine and the symbol shall be printed on every ballot paper opposite to the name of that candidate."

(j) instruments for stamping the official mark on the ballot papers;".

(1) As soon as practicable after the close of the poll, the presiding officer shall, in the presence of such candidates and agents as may be in attendance, make up into packets, properly labelled and sealed with his own seal and the seals of those candidates or their agents who desire to affix their seals

(a) the unused and spoiled ballot papers placed together:

(b) the tendered ballot papers;

- the counterfoils of the used and spoiled ballot papers and of the tendered ballot papers;
- the marked copies of the official list of electors;
- (e) the proxy papers surrendered to the presiding officer:

(f) the poll book,

and shall with all convenient speed deliver the packets to the returning officer, together with the ballot box duly sealed

by the presiding officer.

- (2) The packets shall be accompanied by a statement (in these Regulations referred to as "the ballot paper account") made by the presiding officer showing the number of ballot papers entrusted to him, and accounting for them under the heads of ballot papers in the ballot box, unused, spoiled and tendered ballot papers.
- (3) If any presiding officer shall omit to carry out any of the requirements of this regulation he shall, in addition to any other punishment to which he may be liable, forfeit all right to payment for his services as such officer."






