REGULATIONS

Made Under

THE IMMIGRATION ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 98).

UNDER SECTION 35 OF THE IMMIGRATION CRDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR:

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment)
  Regulations, 1965, and shall be construed and read as one with the
  Immigration Regulations\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal
  Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.
- 2. Paragraph (1) of regulation 11 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended -
  - (a) by the substitution of the words "Accountant General" for the words "Financial Secretary" wherever they appear;
  - (b) by the deletion of the words "with the approval of the Governor", in sub-paragraph (b).
