ORDER IN COUNCIL  
Made Under  
THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE IT IS HEREBY  
ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) Order, 1961.

2. Part III of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended by the insertion after the words "labels for garments", in item 45 of the words "elastic, hooks and eyes, bias binding, ribbons, laces".
