THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE

(Chapter 309.)

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) Order, 1961.
2. The import duties of customs specified in Part I of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, on the articles set out in the schedule hereto are hereby increased to the extent indicated therein.
