Made Under
THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 1 OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) Order, 1961.
2. The second proviso to the Trade Classification List and Tariff of Part I of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time is hereby further amended by the insertion of the following new items —

	Rate of import duty	
	Preferential tariff	General tariff
(12) Textile yarns when imported to the satisfaction of the Comptroller for weaving and knitting of fabrics by or on behalf of a manufacturer of textiles.	Free	5%
(13) Greige fabrics when imported to the satisfaction of the Comptroller for use in a textile dyeing and finishing factory.	Free	5%
(14) Chemicals when imported to the satisfaction of the Comptroller for use in a textile bleaching, dyeing and finishing factory.	Free	16%
