IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9A OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

1. This Order, which amends the Minimum Wages (Watchmen) Order*, may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Watchmen) (Amendment) Order, 2002, and shall come into operation on 1st October, 2002.

Amendment
of the Principal
Order.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended in the following respects -

(a) by the substitution in clause 3 (1) thereof, for the words "three thousand one hundred and forty-nine dollars" of the words "three thousand three hundred and six dollars;"

(b) by the substitution in clause 3 (2) thereof, for the words "seventy-two dollars" and "five hundred and seventy-one dollars" of the words "seventy-five dollars" and "six hundred dollars", respectively.

3. Where immediately before the commencement of this Order, a


continue to pay:

watchman was in receipt of a wage at a rate higher than that prescribed by clause 2 of the Order, the employer shall nevertheless continue to pay to the watchman wages at the higher rate.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order makes provisions for the payment of increased wages to watchmen.
