1. This Order, which amends the Minimum Wages (Employees in Drug Stores) Order 1984*, may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Employees in Drug Stores) (Amendment) Order 2002, and shall come into operation on 1st October, 2002.



Clerk	\$3,367.00 per week
Cashier	\$3,408.00 per week
Driver	\$3,408.00 per week
Messenger	\$3,367.00 per week
Porter	\$3,259.00 per week
Other unskilled employees	\$3,259.00 per week or \$ 75.00 per hour
Registered Student Trainee	\$15,767.00 per month on first appointment. \$15,084.00 per month after one year.
