MOTION

The Minister of Finance moved the following motion:

WHEREAS the Government of Guyana proposes in association with Parsons and Whittemore Inc. a corporation incorporated in the United States of America, to carry out a study into the establishment of a Pulp Mill and/or a Forests Products Complex in Guyana;

AND WHEREAS the Royal Bank of Canada is willing to enter into an Agreement to establish on behalf of the Government an irrevocable Letter of Credit not exceeding the sum of US\$100,000 together with any interest due thereon in favour of Parsons and Whittemore Inc., to pay for one-half of the estimated cost of the study:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That this National Assembly do authorise the Government to enter **into an Agr**eement with the Royal Bank of Canada for the abovementioned purpose.
