TAX (AMENDMENT)(NO. 2) BILL 1974 - Bill No. 16/1974 published 11.6.74

In accordance with article 80(2) of the Constitution, the Minister of Finance signified Cabinet's recommendation and moved the second reading of the following Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO AMEND THE TAX ACT.

Thereafter the Minister of Finance replied.

The Bill was then read a second time and was, thereafter, taken through its remaining stages and passed as printed with the following corrections:

(i) Clause 2:

Substitution of the word "persons" for the word "person" in the second line of the definition of "promoter" in paragraph (a).

(ii) Clause 3:

- (a) Substitution of the word "for" for the word "of" at the beginning of the second line of paragraph (e).
- (b) <u>Substitution</u> of "to section 63(1)" for "section 63(1)" at the end of paragraph (e).
