## ITEM 1 - ELECTION LAWS (AMENDMENT) BILL 2006 - Bill No. 7/2006 published on 2006-03-28

The Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs, moved the second reading of the following Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT to amend the Representation of the People Act and the Election Laws (Amendment) Act 2000.

Thereafter, the Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs replied.

The Bill was then read a second time.

The Assembly resolved itself into Committee to consider the Bill clause by clause.

### In Committee

Clause 1 was passed as printed.

### Clause 2

The Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs, moved the following amendment, which was put and carried:

"For the words "50(2) and 61(2)(a)" substitute the words "50(2), 58(3), 61(2)(a), 70(4) and form 2 in the Schedule".

Clause 2 was then passed as amended.

### Clause 3

The Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs, moved the following amendment, which was <u>put</u> and <u>carried</u>:

"For the words "and 61(3)" substitute the words ", 61(3)" and form 23A in the Schedule".

<u>Clause 3</u> was then <u>passed</u> as <u>amended</u>.

### Clause 4 was passed as printed.

### Clause 5

The Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs, moved the following amendments, which were <u>put</u> and <u>carried</u>:

"Section 84 of the Representation of the People Act is amended in the following respects -

(1A)(a) Where an election officer for a polling district discovers a material error on the Statement of Poll from a polling station for that polling district he shall inform the presiding officer for that polling station forthwith, and the presiding officer, if the Statement of Poll has not yet been sent to the Returning Officer, in the presence of the persons who signed the original Statement of Poll, shall prepare a corrected Statement of Poll signed by himself and the original signatories present and the corrected Statement of Poll shall be sent to the Returning Officer.

(b) Where the mistake is discovered when the Statement of Poll is in the possession of the Returning Officer, the presiding officer shall be informed of the mistake and the Returning Officer shall summon the presiding officer and the persons who signed the original Statement of Poll, for the purpose of effecting the necessary correction to the Statement of Poll by the presiding officer in the presence of the other persons mentioned in this paragraph, as attend.

(c) The presiding officer shall post the corrected Statement of Poll next to the original incorrect Statement of Poll at his polling station and the Returning Officer shall use the corrected Statement of Poll in making the public declaration under subsection (1)".

Clause 5 was then passed as amended.

### Clauses 6 to 10 were passed as printed.
