ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (ELECTIONS) ACT, 1969,  
(No. 23 of 1969).

UNDER SECTION 8(1) OF THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (ELECTIONS) ACT, 1969, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE MINISTER AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Authorities (Elections) (Registration of Voters) (No. 2) Order, 1970.
2. The electoral registrar of every local authority area specified in the first schedule is hereby required to prepare a register of voters for the local authority area of which he is the electoral registrar.
3. The 30th April, 1970, shall be the qualifying date with reference to which a person shall be qualified to be registered in pursuance of this Order.
4. The days set out in the second column of the second schedule shall be the days with reference to which the matters set out in the first column of the said schedule opposite such days, respectively, shall be done.

2. The days to be specified in the notice published under section 12 of the Act on which applications may be made for registration as voters.	Friday, 18th September, 1970, to Monday, 21st September, 1970 (Both days inclusive).
3. The days on which objections may be lodged against the inclusion of names in the preliminary lists and on which applications may be made by persons whose names appear in the preliminary list for correction of their particulars as shown in the list.	Friday, 18th September, 1970, to Monday, 21st September, 1970, (Both days inclusive).
4. The day not later than which the supplementary lists and all forms of objections and applications for correction of particulars shall be sent by the assistant electoral registrar to the electoral registrar under section 19 of the Act.	Thursday, 24th September, 1970.
5. The day not later than which the electoral registrar shall hear and determine objections and applications for correction of particulars under section 20 of the Act.	Wednesday, 30th September, 1970.
6. The day not later than which the electoral registrar shall correct the preliminary and supplementary lists under section 22 of the Act.	Thursday, 1st October 1970.
