THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1955, (No. 30 of 1955).

- UNDER SECTION 9(5) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1955, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVENOR AS FOLLOWS:—
- 1. This Order may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Vesting) (No. 1) Order, 1964.
- 2. The works described in the schedule hereto in the Mahaicony/Abary Drainage and Irrigation Area shall vest in and become the property of the Board.

SCHEDULE

- 1. A check sluice on the 'Jaisingh Distributary' immediately north of its junction with the Jugdeo Distributary.
- 2. A bridge across the 'Jaisingh Distributary' and along the alignment of the dam south of the Second Point Drain.
- 3. A stop-off across the Second Point Drain and immediately west of the Second Point Sluice on the left bank of the Abary River.
- 4. A distributary being the diversion of a portion of the original Burma Distributary with a bank on the southern and western and northern sides commencing from its junction with the aforesaid Burma Distributary at a point immediately south of the Rice Development Company factory compound and about 750 ft. south of the Esau and Jacob Drain and running westwards for approximately 760 ft. thence northwards for approximately 1120 ft. thence eastwards for approximately 660 ft. around the Rice Development Company factory compound thence in a northerly direction west of and adjacent to the Burma Road to the Hyde Park Drain.
- 5. A bridge west of the Rice Development Company factory compound and across the distributary mentioned at 4 above and in alignment with the dam south of the Esau and Jacob Distributary.
- 6. A stop-off at the eastern end of the Esau and Jacob distributary and immediately east of its junction with the distributary mentioned at 4 above.

- 7. A tailwall at the northern extremity of the distributary mentioned at 4 above and approximately 50 ft. south of the Hyde Park Drain.
- 8. A drain known as 'Kingston Drain' lying along the reserve between the 3rd and 4th depth lands on the right bank of the Mahaicony River and extending from its junction with the Governor De Lyte Drain northwards to the dam south of the Esau and Jacob Distributary.
- 9. A dam known as 'Kingston Dam' lying west of and adjacent to the drain described at 8 above.
- 10. A distributary known as 'Kingston Distributary' with a bank on the the western side lying along the reserve between the 3rd and 4th depth lands on the right bank of Mahaicony River and extending from its junction with the Esau and Jacob Distributary southwards to the dam north of the Governor De Lyte Drain.
- 11. A bridge along the dam south of the Esau and Jacob Distributary and across the distributary described at 10 above.
- 12. A drain known as 'Ragnauth Drain' lying along the reserve between the 3rd and 4th depth lands on the right bank of the Mahaicony River and extending from its junction with the Hyde Park Drain southwards to the dam north of the Esau and Jacob Distributary.
- 13. A dam known as 'Ragnauth Dam' lying west of and adjacent to the drain described at 12 above.
- 14. A drain commencing from its junction with the 'Ragnauth Drain' at a point approximately 2400 ft. south of the Hyde Park Drain and running westwards across the 'Ragnauth Dam' thence northwards and adjacent to the aforesaid 'Ragnauth Dam' for a distance of approximately 2100 ft.
- 15. A drain commencing from its junction with the 'Ragnauth Drain' at a point approximately 2900 ft. south of the Hyde Park Drain and running westwards across the 'Ragnauth Dam' thence southwards and adjacent to the aforesaid 'Ragnauth Dam' for a distance of approximately 2300 ft.
- 16. A drain commencing from its junction with the 'Ragnauth Drain' at a point approximately 5300 ft. south of the Hyde Park Drain and running westwards across the 'Ragnauth Dam' thence southwards and adjacent to the aforesaid 'Ragnauth Dam' for a distance of approximately 2300 ft.
- 17. A stop-off at the western extremity of the Esau and Jacob Distributary and immediately west of the reserve between the 2nd and 3rd depth lands on the right bank of the Mahaicony River; north of the aforesaid Esau and Jacob Distributary.

- 18. A bridge situated along the dam south of the Esau and Jacob Drain and approximately 150 ft. west of the stop-off described at 17 above.
- 19. A distributary known as 'Simpson Distributary' with a bank on the western side lying along the reserve between the 2nd and 3rd depth lands on the right bank of the Mahaicony River from its junction with the Esau and Jacob Distributary and extending northwards to a point just south of the Hyde Park Drain.
- 20. A dam known as 'Simpson Dam' lying east of and adjacent to the 'Simpson Distributary' described at 19 above.
- 21. A dam known as 'Jugdeo Dam' situated north of and adjacent to the Jugdeo Distributary running from Mora Point on the Mahaicony River to the Third Point on the Abary River.
- 22. A distributary known as 'Governor De Lyte Distributary' with a bank on the southern side and a dam on the northern side lying along the Governor De Lyte Reserve from its junction with the Burma Distributary westwards to a point just east of the reserve between the 3rd and 4th depth lands on the right bank of the Mahaicony River.
- 23. A stop-off at the western extremity of the Governor De Lyte Distributary described at 22 above.
- 24. A dam north of and adjacent to the Governor De Lyte Drain extending from its junction with the 'Kingston Dam' described at 9 above westwards to the facade drain running along the right bank of the Mahaicony River.
- 25. A distributary known as the 'Esau and Jacob Distributary' with a bank on the northern side lying along the Esau and Jacob Reserve from its junction with the Burma Distributary westwards to its junction with 'Simpson Distributary' described at 19 above.
- 26. A drain known as the 'Esau and Jacob Drain' lying along the Esau and Jacob Reserve from a point immediately west of the stop-off described at 17 above westwards to the facade drain running along the right bank of the Mahaicony River.
- 27. A dam south of and adjacent to the Esau and Jacob Drain and Distributary extending from its junction with the bank west of the Burma Distributary westwards to the facade drain running along the right bank of the Mahaicony River.
- 28. That portion of the irrigation trench known as 'Burma Drain' extending from its junction with the Hyde Park Drain southwards to the stop-off at the eastern entrance of the Rice Development Company factory compound.
- 29. A distributary running from Mora Point on the right bank of the Mahaicony River eastwards to the Third Point on the left bank of the Abary River; locally known as 'Jugdeo Canal' and formerly a drainage and irrigation trench.

30. A drain running along the right bank of the Mahaicony River from Mora Point northwards to Hyde Park, formerly a drainage and irrigation trench and known as the Mahaicony facade drain.
