1. This Order may be cited as the Constitution (Amendment) Order 1987.

- (a) by the insertion, after the words "applies are", of the words "Antigua and Barbuda,";
- (b) by the insertion, after the words "Barbados,", of the words "Belize,";
- (c) by the insertion, after the words "Botswana,", of the words "Brunei,";
- (d) by the insertion, after the words "Malaysia,", of the words "Maldives,";
- (e) by the substitution, for the words "Saint Lucia, St. Vincent", of the words "Saint Christopher and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines,";
- (f) by the insertion, after the words "United Kingdom and Colonies,", of the words "Vanuatu,";
- (g) by the substitution, for the words "and Zambia", of the words "Zambia and Zimbabwe".
