THE ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE, (Chapter 143)

UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE, IT IS HERE-BY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Antibiotics (Albamycin) Order, 1956.
- 2. The following is hereby declared to be an antibiotic to which the provisions of the Antibiotics Ordinance shall apply —

Albamycin, all compounds of Albamycin and all medicinal preparations containing albamycin.
