THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, (Chapter 280).

UNDER SECTION 50 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Georgetown) (No. 2) Order, 1961.
- 2. No motor vehicle of any class nor dray cart nor other cart whatsoever drawn by animals or pushed by hand shall park as follows:—
 - (i) on the eastern side of High Street between its junction with D'Urban Street and its junction with Princess Street.
 - (ii) on the western side of High Street between its junction with Leopold Street and its junction with Harel Street.
 - (iii) on the southern side of Commerce Street between its junction with Longden Street and its juction with Water Street.
 - (iv) between the hours of 5.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m. on the southern side of Middle Street between its junction with East Street and its junction with Thomas Street.
 - (v) on the southern side of Church Street between its junction with Camp Street and its junction with Thomas Street.
 - (vi) on the southern side of Duncan Street between its junction with Vlissengen Road and its junction with Sheriff Street.
