# **ORDER**

#### MADE UNDER

# THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 5).

UNDER SECTION 40 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Delegation of Powers (No. 2) Order, 1965.
- 2. The Minister for the time being charged with the responsibility for Forestry, Lands and Mines is hereby deputed to exercise on behalf of the Governor the power specified in the first column of the schedule to this Order conferred on the Governor by the Ordinance mentioned in the second column of the said schedule, subject however to the following conditions and qualifications
  - (a) that the delegation of power mentioned herein shall remain in force only until varied or revoked by the Governor;
  - (b) that the exercise of the power delegated by this Order shall be subject to any direction, either general or particular, which the Governor may from time to time give in that respect.
- 3. The delegation of the power mentioned herein to the Member of the Executive Council for the time being charged with the responsibility for the subjects of trade and industry on the 26th day of October, 1960, is hereby revoked.
