Under subsection (5) of section 3 of the United Kingdom Forces (Jurisdiction of Colonial Courts) Order 1965 and in exercise of all powers enabling me in that behalf, I do hereby, acting in my discretion, order as follows —

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as the United Kingdom Forces (Offences) Order 1965.

Prescription of offences (First and second schedules) 2. The offences set out in the first and second schedules hereto are hereby prescribed as the offences against the law of British Guiana which shall respectively be offences against the person and offences against property for the purposes of section 3 of the United Kingdom Forces (Jurisdiction of Colonial Courts) Order 1965.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

Offences against the person.

(1) All offences punishable under Titles 5, 6, 7, 8 (except section 82 relating to bigamy) and 9 and under sections 220, 221, 222 and 355 of the Criminal Law (Offences) Ordinance.

(2) All offences punishable under Title 4 of the Summary Jurisdiction (Offences) Ordinance.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

Offences against Property.

(1) All offences punishable under Titles 11 (except sections 154 to 157), 12, 13, 15 and 16 and under sections 223, 224, 225 and 226 of the Criminal Law (Offences) Ordinance.

(2) The offence punishable under section 108 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance.

(3) All offences punishable under Titles 6 and 7 of the Summary Jurisdiction (Offences) Ordinance.
